SUMMARY:

Imagine a helmet whose primary goal is to protect a person from dying from smoke from a fire, radiation from a nuclear explosion, and bioweapons such as a man-made virus. The Gadel X is the helmet that you would need in this dangerous world. Once the person wears it, it will form a protective barrier that will help the user walk through hazardous areas and into a safer place.

Powered by 8 lithium re-chargeable batteries that are charged for up to 6 hours using USB ports, the Gadel X helmet is armed with all the necessary components to help the user survive dangerous circumstances. Essential components, such as an internal oxygen tank with an oxygen level sensor built into



the helmet, allow normal breathing in a zero-oxygen atmosphere. While working hand in hand with the oxygen tank is the oxygen purifier, which converts carbon dioxide to oxygen, thus sending it back to the oxygen tank when needed. In addition to the life support system, the Gadel X helmet's electronic unit is revolutionary with its HUD screen, allowing the user to see virtual navigation to visualize an escape route, in-visor tele-video conference, and full-on surround sound capabilities for added situational awareness. For further adeptness, it has Bluetooth and GPS integration via the user's phone, which provides the head counter capability that allows first responders to geolocate the user of the Gadel X helmet in correlation with their location on the map.

Like the proverbial saying, "Necessity is the mother of invention," the Gadel X helmet is an invention created to survive a calamity, such as a fire, a nuclear incident, or pandemics. It's an innovative invention that has market potential in the military, first responders, and consumer categories.
